Charleston First Church of the Nazarene - January 29th & 30th

The next Basic Archery Instructor training scheduled for January 29th and 30th at Charleston First Church of the Nazarene is full.



We are finalizing plans now for April training. Please visit our website www.wvdnr.gov for additional information as it comes available.

Training cost is \$25 for all school personnel and \$50 for non-school personnel. This covers cost of training materials. Teachers are responsible for lodging, travel, and meals.

Interested in Hosting Training?

Are you interested in holding trainings in your area? If you have 10 PE teachers and/or coaches we will come to you to hold a training.

Those wishing to host a training must have an adequately-sized facility available, adequately staffed, open to us for a 3-day period (during the week), and is free of charge.

A BAI Attendee Enrollment Form needs to be filled and emailed as an attachment. This form needs to be completely filled out before plans can be finalized by the coordinator.

2013 WV State Qualifying Virtual Tournament

Schools wishing to participate in the 2013 State Archery in the Schools Tournament must participate in the State Qualifying Virtual Tournament. Schools may participate in the State Virtual Tournament by either shooting with at least one other school or hosting a tournament in your own school and use the letter of score verification from the Principal. Schools must register online at

www.nasptournaments.org. You will need to create a username and password. (May want to keep record of this because it is needed each time you login.) If you need assistance, please use the help link on the website.

The State Qualifying Virtual Tournament is open now until 5:00 pm February 22nd. Scores will be finalized and posted by February 25th close of business.

The Top 8 teams, Top 10 Males, and Top 10 Females per age division will qualify to participate in the 2013 WV Archery in the Schools State Tournament March 23, 2013 at the Charleston Civic Center.



8th Annual West Virginia State Archery in the Schools Tournament

The WV DNR will host the 8th Annual WV State Archery in the Schools Tournament March 23, 2013 at the Charleston Civic Center.

Schools that qualify through the State Qualifying Virtual Tournament will compete to be the top Archery in the Schools teams and individuals in the state. One change for this year's tournament is team size may be up to 16 shooters. Teams

sending 16 must have 5 of the opposite gender. The Top 12 shooters will be used to determine winners.

First place teams in each division are automatically qualified to attend the 2013 NASP Nationals May 10-11, 2013 at the Kentucky Exposition Center. Additional teams may attend with qualifying team scores. 1st-5th place male and females, individual winners

in the 4th, 5th, and 6th grades, and 1st-5th place in the Middle School and High School Divisions qualify to attend.

Specific information on the State Tournament (rules, shooting times, etc.) will be posted on the WV DNR website in the coming weeks. Also all those that qualify will receive a packet after February 25th.
