



West Virginia Archery in the Schools Program

2019-2020 Tournament Prep Sheet

All official NASP® Tournaments will follow the 2020 NASP® National, Open & Champion Tournament Rules. Please ensure that all rules, including the following, are being enforced. Any tournament that does not follow all rules will not be recognized as an official NASP® Tournament. The tournament host Basic Archery Instructor (BAI) is responsible for participant safety and the enforcement of these rules.

Range Setup (Section 4.1)

- The waiting line will be at least 4-5 yards or meters beyond the 15-meter shooting line (4.1.6).
- No more than three coaches from each team will be in Coach's Alley with proper credentials (4.1.7.1).

Arrow Handling and Movement About the Range (Section 4.3)

- The tournament-provided arrow quiver must be placed ON the shooting line in FRONT of the archer (4.3.4).
- Shooter and quiver must remain in each archer's half of the assigned lane when on the shooting line. No part of the archers' body or the quiver may cover, or be past, their lane marks (4.3.5).
- Arrow points must be covered with one hand and shafts grasped below the vanes with the other hand when walking with arrows (4.3.8). Archers must carry arrows with both hands when returning arrows to the quiver.
- Archers must walk at all times while on the range (4.3.1).
- Archers must remain on their feet (standing) and off their knees when pulling arrows (4.3.7).
- REMINDER: Arrows must always remain under the control of the coach, except when students are shooting.

Whistle Commands (Section 4.2)

- NASP® whistle commands will be used to operate the range (4.2).

Scoring (Section 5)

- Only archers and tournament officials will be permitted down range of the waiting area (5.1).
- All arrows must be scored before any arrow of the target's face is touched (5.2).
- Once arrows are scored, one archer will move safely behind the Target Line while the other pulls his own arrows, then the archers will reverse positions (5.7.7 – 5.7.8).
- REMINDER: Students are not permitted to score their own arrows. If an archer is in a lane by themselves, a lane official must score the arrows.

As the NASP® Tournament host BAI, I confirm that I have read and understand the 2020 NASP® National, Open & Champion Tournament Rules, and all rules will be followed and enforced. I also realize that if I do not comply with any part of these rules, I am not hosting an official NASP® tournament and am responsible for any issues that may arise.
