Membership and Fish Registration Application

The West Virginia Husky Musky Club is an organization of musky anglers dedicated to the preservation and enhancement of musky fishing in West Virginia. Our members are men and women who practice and maintain the highest level of integrity and sportsmanship in observance of the game and fish laws of the State of West Virginia and by-laws of the WVHMC.

Membership Rules

To be eligible for membership, an angler must catch a legal sized muskellunge (30 inches or longer measured from the tip of the snout to the end of the tail) on rod and reel from West Virginia waters. The application must be filled out, signed by one other adult witness and mailed to the WVHMC within 30 days of the catch. The angler submitting this application automatically becomes a club member dues free for a year and will be presented a membership certificate at the annual awards banquet.

Special certificates and awards are presented to those anglers who catch a musky 40 inches or more in length. Other club awards include: an award to active member who catches the longest musky each year, jacket patches for 6, 25 and 100 documented releases, a patch for all 40 inch and over releases, release tournament catches, a husky patch for the first musky over 40 inches, a Mr. Musky award and a Master Musky award.
