

REPORTING PROCEDURES FOR RECORD FISH

A record of the largest fish of each species taken by **hook and line** in West Virginia waters is maintained. Certificates of accomplishment are awarded for each record holder.

Any angler landing a potential record breaker should report his catch to Wildlife Resources Section, Division of Natural Resources, Charleston WV, 25305. A photograph of the fish is desirable (color preferred). A WV DNR fishery biologist must verify the species of fish.
