



Beyond BOW—Women’s Squirrel Hunt

Come and learn the thrill of small game hunting with experienced guides from West End Outfitters. This trip will be limited to 6 women to ensure a fun and safe experience. To make this hunt even more interesting, dogs will be used to help locate “treed” squirrels.

Your day will start by meeting the guides early that Saturday morning at the Sam Black Church Exit of 1-64. Then you will car pool to Greenbrier State Forest to receive training about equipment, gear, history of squirrel hunting, and the advantages/disadvantages of using dogs. After this brief discussion, your group will hike around with the guides and squirrel dogs. If hunters acquire the squirrel possession limit, participants may finish the day with a short fishing trip for no extra charge.

The registration fee covers guide service and a picnic lunch. Lodging is not included in this event, but there are various facilities in Dawson, Lewisburg, and White Sulphur Springs. Also, participants are required to provide a valid WV hunting license, shotgun, and ammo (12 gauge, #6 shot or 20 gauge, #5 shot).
