## 2009 CONTROLLED DEER HUNT

### STONEWALL RESORT STATE PARK

#### Application Instructions

1. West Virginia Residents and holders of West Virginia Lifetime Licenses may apply for a permit to participate in the Stonewall Resort State Park Controlled Deer Hunt on November 16-18, 2009. Hunters may apply individually or as part of a two person party and may use any weapon legal for deer hunting in West Virginia. One (1) deer may be taken by each hunter. Only antlerless deer may be taken during this hunt, except that each day of the hunt an on-site lottery will be held which will allow up to four (4) hunters to hunt an either sex deer. Follow instructions on the accompanying license application exactly.
2. All applicants must designate the type of weapon (firearm or bow) and hunting method (free roaming or fixed stand) to be used. All persons applying as a party must hunt with the same type of weapon (firearm or bow) and use the same method of hunting (free roaming or fixed stand). Party hunters which include a Class Q hunter must hunt from the same Class Q stand. A Class Q hunter is a physically challenged hunter permanently disabled in both lower extremities.
3. Applications must be signed, legible, complete, and postmarked by August 28, 2009. An individual's name may only appear on one application. Violation of any of these conditions will disqualify the applicant. Permits will be selected at random for each hunt day. The applicant may request to be placed on the lottery for no more than one (1) hunt day.
4. Each hunter must possess a valid West Virginia Hunting License (or be legally exempt from purchasing a license) on the day of the hunt. The hunt area is divided into two zones; a Fixed Stand Zone and a Free Roaming Zone. In the Fixed Stand Zone hunters must hunt from elevated tree stands (ladder or self climbing), which they must provide, placed in designated trees. In the Free Roaming Zone hunters may hunt from the ground or from portable tree stands and they are not limited to a stationary location. A safety belt is required to be worn while hunting from an elevated stand. Scopes are allowed on all legal firearms. There will be no waiting list or walk-ons, however, there will be a limited number of hunters selected for the hunt but not assigned until the morning of the hunt.
5. West Virginia Division of Natural Resources hunting regulations will apply to this hunt. However, deer taken during this hunt will NOT count against the hunter's annual deer season bag limit.
6. There are a limited number of Physically Challenged sites available for persons with a Class Q Permit (see definition in hunting regulations). If you have a class Q permit, enter your Class Q Permit number in the space provided in order to be considered for physically challenged hunting accommodations.
7. These rules and regulations, along with all applicable deer hunting regulation will be strictly enforced. Any violation may result in prosecution, expulsion from the state park and elimination from the remainder of the hunt.
