Dear Spring Gobbler Hunter:

We need your help. We would like you to help us manage West Virginia wild turkeys by participating in our annual Spring Gobbler Survey. The survey simply records your turkey hunting activities and harvest. It is important to return your survey regardless if you hunt all season or just a day or two. Any information we receive is valuable to us.

Enclosed is a Spring Gobbler Survey form. Keep it with you or post it in a prominent place such as your refrigerator, and fill it out each time you go turkey hunting. Most hunters enjoy keeping track of the various animals seen and heard. A questionnaire is also part of the survey. Please feel free to provide us questions, comments regarding the survey or your hunting experience.

At the close of the season, simply tape or staple the form with the return address on the outside, affix the correct postage and mail. All cooperators returning the survey form will receive a copy of the annual Spring Gobbler Survey Report. **Be sure you record your name and address on the outside of the survey form in the space provided.** We cannot mail you a report without your address!

Thanks in advance for your participation. We truly appreciate your cooperation and look forward to your assistance in managing the wild turkey resource. Good luck on all of your hunting endeavors.
